Why Billet?

Being a billet family is more than offering a place to stay—it's about creating a home environment where a young athlete feels supported, encouraged, and part of something bigger. The bond between a player and their billet family often becomes a lasting friendship that goes far beyond the season.

Hosting 101: Your Role

- Supply a bedroom/bed for the player
- Offer meals and basic household needs

- Transportation is NOT required of the billet family
- Background Checks: Required by the league (cost covered by River Hawks)

- Monthly stipend: \$600/month to help cover food and household expenses (for each player housed)
